

OSCE Checklist: Vaginal Swabs

1 G 2 W 3 Ir 4 C 5 E 6 E 7 G 8 A	coduction Gather equipment Wash your hands and don PPE if appropriate Introduce yourself to the patient including your name and role Confirm the patient's name and date of birth Explain what the procedure will involve using patient-friendly language Explain the need for a chaperone Gain consent to proceed with taking vaginal swabs Lisk the patient if they have any pain before taking vaginal swabs Lisk the patient to remove their underwear for the procedure and provide them with privacy whilst they get undressed	
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Vul	val inspection	
10 D	on gloves and position the patient in the modified lithotomy position	
11 lr	nspect the vulva	
Inse	erting the speculum	
12 R	Re-check that the patient is happy to continue with the procedure	
13 L	ubricate the speculum	
14 U	Jse your left hand (index finger and thumb) to separate the labia	
15 G	Gently insert the speculum sideways (blades closed, angled downwards and backwards)	
16 O	Once inserted, rotate the speculum back 90° (so that the handle is facing upwards)	
17 O	pen the speculum blades until an optimal view of the cervix is achieved	
18 T	ighten the locking nut to fix the position of the blades	
Visu	ualising the cervix	
19 Ir	nspect the cervix	
Tak	ing the vaginal swabs	
	rick up the swab's sample tube using your dominant hand and pass it to your non-dominant and	
21 R	Remove the lid of the sample tube using your dominant hand and place in the tray	
22 P	rick up the swab itself with your dominant hand and take the relevant samples	
	Place the used swab back into its tube, which should still be in your non-dominant hand and ghten the lid	
24 P	Place the completed swab into the tray	

Re	Removing the speculum			
25	Loosen the locking nut on the speculum and partially close the blades			
26	Rotate the speculum 90°, back to its original insertion orientation			
27	Gently remove the speculum, inspecting the walls of the vagina as you do so			
28	Re-cover the patient and explain the examination is complete			
29	Dispose of the used equipment into a clinical waste bin			
To	To complete the procedure			
30	Label the samples with the relevant details			
31	Thank the patient for their time			
32	Advise the patient that they'll be contacted with results via their preferred method (e.g. face to face or text message)			
33	Dispose of PPE appropriately and wash your hands			
34	Document the procedure in the medical notes including the details of the chaperone			
35	Send the vaginal swabs to the lab for processing			
36	Suggest further assessments and investigations (e.g. urinalysis, abdominal examination, bimanual vaginal examination)			

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
