

## OSCE Checklist | Elbow Pain History Taking

Opening the consultation				
1	Wash your hands and don PPE if appropriate			
2	Introduce yourself to the patient including your name and role			
3	Confirm the patient's name and date of birth			
4	Explain that you'd like to take a history from the patient			
5	Gain consent to proceed with taking a history			
Presenting complaint				
6	Use open questioning to explore the patient's presenting complaint			
Hi	History of presenting complaint			
7	Site: ask about the location of the elbow pain			
8	Onset: clarify when the elbow pain first started and if it the onset was sudden or gradual			
9	Character: ask about the specific characteristics of the elbow pain			
10	Radiation: ask if the elbow pain moves anywhere else			
11	Associated symptoms: ask if there are any other associated symptoms (e.g. swelling, redness, weakness)			
12	Time course: ask how the elbow pain has changed over time			
13	Exacerbating or relieving factors: ask if anything makes the elbow pain worse or better			
14	Severity: ask how severe the elbow pain is on a scale of 0-10			
15	Explore the patient's ideas, concerns and expectations			
16	Summarise the patient's presenting complaint			
Sy	ystemic enquiry			
17	Screen for relevant symptoms in other body systems			
Pa	Past medical and surgical history			
18	Ask if the patient has any medical conditions including previous elbow problems			
19	Ask if the patient has undergone any relevant surgical procedures			
20	Ask if the patient has any allergies and if so, clarify what kind of reaction they had to the substance			
Drug history				
21	Ask if the patient is currently taking any prescribed medications or over-the- counter remedies			
Family history				
22	Ask the patient if there is any family history of joint problems, inflammatory arthritis or			

malignancy (e.g. sarcoma).

Social history			
23	Explore the patient's general social context and impact of symptoms		
24	Take a smoking history		
25	Take an alcohol history		
26	Ask about recreational drug use		
27	Gather details about the patient's occupation		
28	Ask about any hobbies which may be relevant to their elbow pain		
Closing the consultation			
29	Summarise the salient points of the history back to the patient and ask if they feel anything has been missed		
30	Thank the patient for their time		
31	Dispose of PPE appropriately and wash your hands
